# BOROUGH OF BOGOTA Mayor and Council Work Session Meeting

Meeting of the Borough of Bogota Mayor and Council meeting held on this date April 6, 2023 in Borough Hall, 375 Larch Ave, Bogota, New Jersey at 7:00 P.M

The notice for this meeting's time, date, location, and agenda fulfills the "Open Public Meetings Act," P.L.1975, c. 231, requirements.

#### Roll Call

Mayor Kelemen- Absent Council President Carpenter- Present Councilwoman Granquist- Present Councilman McHale- Absent Councilman Mitchell- Present Councilwoman Murphy- Present Councilman Robbins- Present

Also attending were Borough Administrator Hynes, Borough Attorney Betesh and Acting Borough Clerk Flores-Bolivard and Deputy Clerk Baque.

Council President Carpenter led the Pledge of Allegiance.

#### Discussion

Fire Inspector Position

**Councilwoman Murphy** said that everyone was pleased with the candidate for the Fire Inspector position.

Councilwoman Murphy made a motion to hire Ryan T. Smith for the part time Fire Inspector position, which was seconded by Councilman Mitchell. All Councilmembers present voted yes.

## Recreation/Community Center

Councilwoman Murphy said that there was a meeting with the engineer and architect to move forward to expand the recreation/community center at its current site using grant funds and a building cost method. The Borough has a county grant from 2017 that can be applied to the recreation/community center, because the new location is on the same block and lot number that the funds were sought for. Combined with PILOT funding, bonded funds, and the grant, there is about \$8 million available for the project.

**Councilwoman Murphy** made a motion to accept the county grant and authorize the signing of the grant agreement, which was seconded by Councilwoman Granquist. All Councilmembers present voted yes.

Councilwoman Murphy made a motion to authorize the committee to set up meetings with the professionals to move forward with drafting "built to cost" plans for the Recreation/Community Center project, which was seconded by Councilman Mitchell. All Councilmembers present voted yes.

#### **EV** Station

Councilwoman Murphy discussed the possible location for an electric vehicle charging station, the amount of parking spaces required, and the types of stations that are available to be installed.

Borough Attorney Betesh said that while meeting with the Board of Education, the Board decided to find an alternate location to install the EV charging station, as the anticipated construction at the planned location would be too disruptive.

# Fields and Parking Lot-Board of Education Referendum

Borough Attorney Betesh explained that the Board of Education requires approval from the Borough for access to the ballfield, which will allow them to perform testing, surveying, and other site work on the property. The Council has not been presented with a detailed plan for use of the property, this authorization would enable the Board of Education to gather the information required to create such a plan.

Councilwoman Murphy made a motion to give authorization to the Board of Education to whatever steps are necessary to propose a plan for the use of the ballfield at Block 1 Lot 30, which was seconded by Councilwoman Granquist. All Councilmembers present voted yes.

## Public Health Nurse - Regional Program

**Borough Administrator Hynes** recommended the Borough renew the contract with Hackensack Hospital to provide a public health nurse. The nurse tracks communicable diseases, does blood pressure screenings, and will cost approximately \$2,300.

**Councilwoman Granquist** made a motion to renew the contract with Hackensack Hospital for a public health nurse, which was seconded by Councilman Robbins. All Councilmembers Present voted yes.

2023 Sustainable Jersey-PSE&G Energy Efficiency Partnership Program Application

**Borough Administrator Hynes** would like approval to submit an application to the Energy Efficiency Partnership Program. In the program, PSE&G assists businesses, residents and the Borough in finding ways to save energy. He will prepare a resolution for the next Council meeting.

Councilwoman Murphy made a motion to authorize Costa Engineering to go out to bid for resurfacing tennis and basketball courts, which was seconded by Councilman Mitchell. All Councilmembers present voted yes.

Councilman Mitchell made a motion to approve the Regular Meeting Minutes March 16, 2023 and the Closed Session Minutes March 2, 2023, which was seconded by Councilwoman Murphy. All Councilmembers present voted yes, except for Councilman Robbins for March 2, 2023 (absent)

Acting Clerk Flores-Bolivard said the raffle license was for the Special Olympics.

**Councilman Mitchell** made a motion to approve the raffle license, which was seconded by Councilman Robbins. All Councilmembers present voted yes.

**Councilman Mitchell** made a motion to approve PC23-06, which was seconded by Councilman Robbins. All Councilmembers present voted yes.

# Citizen Remarks: One (5) minute time limit per person.

Councilman Mitchell made a motion to open Citizen Remarks, which was seconded by Councilwoman Murphy. The motion passed with a voice vote.

**Danielle Fede**- expressed her concerns that the Council acted on several items of business that were not on the agenda.

Michelle Rupar- supports the Council's work to approve and receive grant funding.

Willy Ortiz- thanked the Council for their hard work in obtaining the grant for Fairview Ave. He requested an update on when the construction work would begin. He referenced a conversation on Facebook about overnight parking. He shared his concerns about unsafe drivers on Fairview Ave.

**Jorge Nunez**-congratulated the Council on taking action on several items that the community was waiting for.

**Susan Harper**-is concerned about people driving through the park and requested signage by the football field and the chain to be replaced. She inquired about whether the basketball and tennis courts would be moved. She said that water pools on the pathway by the baseball dugouts and it does not drain well.

Frank Miranda- praised the strong relationship between the Board of Education and Council and the willingness of everyone to work together for the betterment of the residents of Bogota.

**Councilman Mitchell** made a motion to close Citizen Remarks, which was seconded by Councilwoman Murphy. The motion passed with a voice vote.

Council President Carpenter said that the Council needed to take quick action on the grants, because none of the grants were officially accepted when they were initially awarded. The grants either expired or were about to expire, which caused the Council to act on them during a work session meeting. The Borough cannot start any work on Fairview Ave until a contract is formally signed with NJDOT, after a contract is signed, they will go out bid for the work.

**Councilman Robbins** said that he observed the traffic on Fairview Ave with the police and most of the drivers were under the speed limit. They also used equipment to measure the traffic in the area and there was only one car going over 35mph. He suggested additional painted warnings on the road.

**Councilman Mitchell** made a motion to enter closed session, which was seconded by Councilman Robbins. The motion passed on a voice vote.

Councilwoman Murphy made a motion to enter open session, which was seconded by Councilman Mitchell The motion passed with a voice vote.

Councilwoman Murphy made a motion to adjourn the meeting, which was seconded by Councilman Mitchell. The motion passed with a voice vote.

#### Adjournment

Being no further business before the governing body, Councilman Mitchell made a motion to adjourn, which was seconded by Councilman Robbins. The motion passed on a voice vote.
